## Board Resolution Establishing the Chaplain Corps

**WHEREAS**, the King James Bible Society is committed to the advancement of the Gospel through the pure and preserved Word of God as found in the Authorized King James Version of the Holy Scriptures; and

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to commission and support godly men who are called to minister as chaplains in various settings; and

**WHEREAS**, these chaplains will serve as non-paid volunteers under the spiritual oversight of the King James Bible Society;

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Directors of the King James Bible Society as follows:

1. Establishment of the Chaplain Corps.

The King James Bible Society hereby establishes a Chaplain Corps consisting of qualified Christian men called to serve as chaplains.

2. Purpose.

The purpose of the Chaplain Corps is to provide biblical ministry, counsel, prayer, and the preaching of the Gospel in institutional, community, and other settings, always upholding the Authorized King James Version as the final authority in all matters of faith and practice.

3. Leadership.

The President of the King James Bible Society shall serve as the Chief of Chaplains. In this role, the President shall oversee the Chaplain Corps, issue licenses, provide spiritual guidance, and ensure all chaplains remain faithful to the doctrines and mission of the Society.

4. Status of Chaplains.

All chaplains in the Corps shall serve as non-paid volunteers. They shall receive no salary, compensation, or financial benefit from the King James Bible Society for their chaplaincy service.

5. Oversight and Authority.

All chaplains shall operate under the spiritual oversight and authority of the King James Bible Society. The Board of Directors reserves the right to issue, suspend, or revoke chaplain licenses as it deems necessary.

6. Authorization.

The President, acting as Chief of Chaplains, is hereby authorized to issue official chaplain licenses, maintain records of the Chaplain Corps, and perform all acts necessary to carry out the purposes of this resolution.
